

INTERACTIVE SIMUNITIONS TRAINING USE OF FORCE

*Dedicated to Fallen Officer Michael Briggs,
Manchester Police Department*

This intensive, one-day training program for law enforcement personnel workshop will provide students with hands-on instruction in the use of force continuum and will allow students to escalate and de-escalate through it. The class is designed to be a “step up” from training received at the recruitment level. Participants will be presented with real-life scenarios based on situations facing our communities today. This onsite workshop can be held at facilities that meet training site requirements. Class size will be limited to 10 personnel per training session. **NOTE:** This workshop can be structured to comply with the four-hour firearms re-certification from New Hampshire Police Standards and Training (including review of RSA 627:5, Use of Force).

ABOUT THE INSTRUCTORS

Sgt. Michael Frost (Ret.), Seabrook Police Department, has more than 20 years of training experience. A certified instructor in simunitions, officer survival and firearms, Frost is a Sigarms and Colt Armorer.

Deputy Rick Tyler, Grafton County Sheriff’s Department, has been a full-time police office since 1991. He is a firearms instructor, Swat 1 & 2 operator and Assistant Commander with the Central New Hampshire Special Operations Unit. Tyler is a certified simunitions instructor and holds firearms instructor certifications in revolver, semi-automatic pistol, shot gun, urban rifle, H&K sub gun, chemical agent and ASP baton.

Chief Al “Butch” Burbank (Ret.), Waterville Valley Department of Safety, currently serves as a Risk Management Representative for the LGC. A 27-year veteran of New Hampshire law enforcement, Burbank has spent the majority of his career as an officer and is a survival/firearms instructor who is certified by both New Hampshire Police Standards and Training and Sigarms.
